REMINDER:

The trail south of the Village of Spring Valley closes November 1, 2016 to December 15, 2016 for deer hunting; trail is not groomed in winter. To obtain access to Team Travel Oil (Subway and gas station) on State Hwy 29 follow arrows south on 250th Street from 890th Avenue. Trails south and north of Spring Valley are closed for spring thaw. Note: travel time from Ellsworth to Eau Galle, Weston, Wilson, Woodville, Knapp and Hersey is approximately 1 ½ hours traveling at 30-35 mph. It's about 1 hour to Baldwin, Spring Valley and Elmwood.

Accomplishments in 2016

- Gained access to Bendilly's Bar & Grill on Hwy 63 off 750th Street and to Common Man Brewery in Ellsworth through East Ellsworth. ATV/UTV traffic has increased within Pierce County.
- Routes on Cty VV & EE were proposed and brought to the County Board. By vote of the County Board it was turned down. These routes are necessary to allow access for county residents.
 Members and residents need to lobby the Pierce County Board of Supervisors to allow access on these roads. This also holds true for other areas of Pierce County.
- We had one fundraiser this year: The Moose Lodge Breakfast in River Falls.
- Printed and distributed new updated ATV/UTV maps.
