REMINDERS:

- The trail south of the Village of Spring Valley closes November 1st to December 15th each year for deer hunting; trail is not groomed in winter. To obtain access to Team Travel Oil (Subway and gas station) on State Hwy 29 follow arrows south on 250th Street from 890th Avenue. Trails south and north of Spring Valley are closed for spring thaw. Note: travel time from Ellsworth to Eau Galle, Weston, Wilson, Woodville, Knapp and Hersey is approximately 1 ½ hours traveling at 30-35 mph. It's about 1 hour to Baldwin, Spring Valley and Elmwood.
- Trail closed along CHT V from 610th Street to 620th Street due to property sold to new owners.
